THOMAS REGINALD EDOLS. CANDIDATE FOR CALARE.

Mr. Thomas Reginald Edols, known to everyone as Reg Edols, is a farmer and grazier of Cowan Creek, Baker's Swamp. He is a son of the late Headley Edols, of Burrawong. Mr. Edols is an endorsed Country Party candidate for the Calare

electorate. He is a Shire Councilor of Macquarie Shire, and is a member of the Electricity Committee and of the local Repatriation Committee.

He was previously a Director of the Molong Pastures Protection Board, was a President of the Yarranbandai Farmers and Settlers' Association, as far back as 1920. He has been a member of the Graziers' Association for about 20 years, is a vice-president of the Calare Electorate Council, and a regular delegate from his branch to the Dubbo Country Party Electorate. He has carried out over a period of years, experiments in pasture improvement, in conjunction with the Agricultural Department.

Reg Edols served in the Great war of 1914/18, with the A.I.F. in the Artillery until 1917, when he transferred to the newly formed Australian Flying Corps, serving with the famous 4th Australian Squadron, which had the record for enemy air craft destroyed, which record still stands. He was shot down by anti-aircraft while leading a patrol over enemy territory just before the conclusion of the war, but managed to escape. Mr. Edols was rejected for overseas service in this war on medical grounds, but his only son, who is a Duntroon graduate, is serving overseas as an artillery officer in this war.

Jenifer Hedley Edols Whitecross (1926-1988), veterinary surgeon and administrator, was born on 18 February 1926 at Darlinghurst, Sydney, second child of NSW-born parents **Thomas Reginald Edols**, grazier, and his wife Myrtle Florence Daisy, née Higgins. Jenifer grew up on her father's property Gowan Green, Dripstone, near Wellington. After being educated by correspondence and later as a boarder at Frensham, Mittagong, she studied veterinary science at the University of Sydney (B.V.Sc. 1949), winning the Baker and Ridley memorial prize for animal husbandry. She played first-grade hockey for the university.
