The death took place, at his residence, 27 School Parade, Marrickville, on Wednesday last, of the Rev. William Hotston, who served for 45 years in the Bathurst and Sydney dioceses. During that time he carried out ministerial duties at Carcoar, Cowra, Coonabarabran, Rookwood, Brewarrina, Coolah, Rockley, Parramatta, Drummoyne, Austinmer, and at the time of his death was assisting Archdeacon Boyce at Redfern. He leaves a widow and an adult family of four daughters and five sons.

The death occurred in Sydney at his residence, Marrickville, of Rev. William Hotston, aged 70. The deceased was the father of Mr. **R. H. Hotston**, of the Cootamundra Bank of New South Wales. He had been ailing for some time.

Mr. Dudley Hotston, of Waggonville, received news of the death of his brother Robert, who resided in Perth. He was the second son of the late Rev. William and Mrs. Hotston, of Duwich Hill. After being educated at **All Saints College, Bathurst**, he joined the Bank of N. S. W. In World War 1 he went with the 7th. Light Horse, and saw service in Palestine and Egypt. On his return he was stationed at Cootamundra for several years, and was then appointed manager and sent to Victoria, and from there to Western Australia as an Inspector. He is survived by his mother, four brothers, and four. Sisters.
