Probate in the will of the late David Maxwell Irving, grazier, of Bundilla, near Warren, N.S.W., who died in July last, has been granted. The net value of the estate was set down at £33, 095. Deceased appointed his widow, Ida Louisa Irving, and his son, Herbert Maxwell Irving, grazier, of Bundilla executors and trustees of the estate. To his widow he bequeathed certain property in Brercton Avenue, Marrickville, together with the furniture and household effects contained therein-----.

In the additional service records above, is an indistinct summary of a "charge" which Irving successfully defended. The details of the alleged crime were:

"Charge Section 18 (4) A.A. Whereas on active service stealing public goods in that in Eddud on 4-1-18 stole from the supply depot 5 (five) tins of M&V (Meat & Vegetable) rations 2 (two) tins of jam and a quantity of potatoes and onions valued at 9 shillings and 3 pence. Pleaded not guilty and found not guilty."
