Served at Anzac with 6<sup>th</sup> LHR. Evacuated with dysentery August. To England (Enteric) and returned to Egypt. Thence to France, having transferred as Gunner. Service with 15<sup>th</sup>.25<sup>th</sup>.14<sup>th</sup>, Field Artillery Brigades. Gassed 7/8/17, to hospital England. Discharged 1/7/19.
